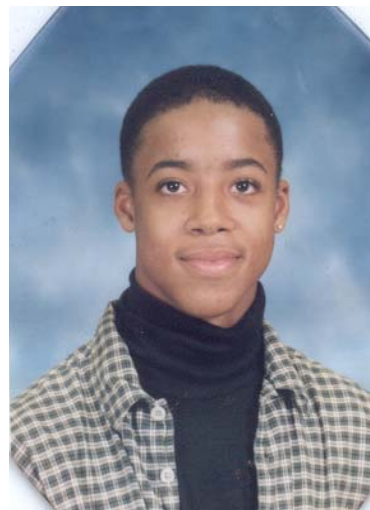

HUMAN INTEREST:

Cordell started track in grade 5 but did not take it seriously until grade 9 when his soccer coach suggested that he was running too fast for the ball. He joined Mississauga Track and Field club in September 2000. Since then he has set indoor records for the 200m, 4x200 relay, medley relay and has been ranked 1st in: 200m: 60m: 100m & 400m. He has been voted Athlete of the year in Jr. High and has been named MVP for Track & Field each year in high school. He has also appeared in the Athletics Canada Magazine on several occasions as well as being named one of the world's top 20 in the 200m.

As a midget, (15yrs old) athlete he set a new provincial indoor record for the 200m (22.89s). As a Juvenile, (16yrs old) he set another indoor record for 200m (22.52s). Also placed 1st in Canada for under 17 outdoor 200m (21.66s). Cordell prefers the 200m event but is very capable of running a successful 100m(10.84s PB) and has posted a (50.8s 400m) only running the distance on a couple of occasions.

In 2003, Cordell sustained a torn hamstring but still managed to run 100m (10.84s) and 200m(22.10s).

He was born in Oakville, the hometown of Donovan Bailey, thus leaving Cordell with aspirations of one day going to the Olympics to represent Canada like Donovan.

He lives at home with his mother, grandmother and aunt. Of note is that his mother also competed in Track and Field track at the same high school Cordell now attends (Mother- Penny, was a member of the 4X100 relay team that set an Ontario High School record for midget girls). Cordell is versatile athlete who also played soccer: basketball as well being a wide receiver on the High School Varsity Football team. Cordell has aspirations of going into Sports Management/Media or Theatre Arts.
