TO ALL MISSISSAUGA TRACK AND FIELD CLUB MEMBER FAMILIES

Please find attached your copy of the Bingo Schedule to the end of December 2003. As a member of the club, each and every family has accepted the obligation to fully participate in staffing an allotted share of Bingos and to continue that obligation throughout the entire year. Bingo dates are assigned to the Mississauga Track and Field Club by the Bingo City Sponsors'.

It is your responsibility to:

- Arrive on time (8:45 pm) for each and every scheduled Bingo. Captains must contact the assigned members in advance of each Bingo and should do so at least 5-7 days prior in order to surface any potential problems.
- Participate fully in the position for which you are scheduled.
- Familiarize yourself with the position for which you are scheduled. If you have not participated in Bingo, please arrive early the first time in order to understand your responsibilities.
- Make alternate arrangements with people willing to substitute for any Bingo(s) at which you are unable to participate. All changes must be made known to the captain(s) of the respective Bingo at least 2 days before your scheduled bingo date.

We recommend adult members to participate in Bingo. Non adult members must be sixteen years of age or over to work at the Bingo. Persons who are not members of the club are prohibited from doing Bingo on behalf of a member. A member is defined as a registered athlete or the parent(s) or guardian(s) of that registered athlete.

Bingo is our greatest source of outside revenue and is essential to the financial stability of the club. As per our club policy, there is a \$100 fee for any assigned Bingo you do not attend without arranging a substitute. As well, the manager or coach may refuse to enter the athlete in any or all subsequent competitions until the matter is resolved.
